For a manufactured home to meet SC’s standards for energy efficiency, the home must have the following:

1. Storm or double pane glass windows;
2. Insulated or storm doors;
3. A minimum thermal resistance rating of R-11 for walls, R-19 for floors, and R-30 for ceilings OR allowances in the energy efficiency levels for walls, floors, and ceilings, so long as the heat loss does not exceed that calculated using the R levels stated above. These heat loss calculations are based on the current edition of the American Society of Heating, Refrigeration, and Air-Conditioning Engineers Guide at the time of the home’s manufacture.
