### Action Items 2&3:

Question re: fees or other “influences” imposed by electrical carriers in areas not yet served by gas lines

- **Action Item:** PNG will modify its language to reflect storage facilities in NC that support SC customers and send to Duke to incorporate into latest draft

- **Action Item:** ORS will add language address its pipeline safety program activities/responsibilities.

An initial bullet list of policy questions to be considered in Phase II was started:

- Customer choice
- Economic Development
- Capacity—specifically reserve Capacity
- Forecasting
- Vehicle fuel infrastructure development

A brief discussion followed on adding a bullet to reflect a conversation between PNG and Energy Office which focused on Propane availability/infrastructure (i.e. Fueling Stations, Fleet Adoption, etc.) – **Action Item:** PNG to draft a Bullet to reflect this suggestion; **Action Item:** ORS will contact the SC Propane Association to solicit their input regarding propane pipeline and distribution in the current narrative. Several people suggested that the Palmetto State Clean Fuels Coalition may provide an avenue for this type of collaboration/discussion in the future.
