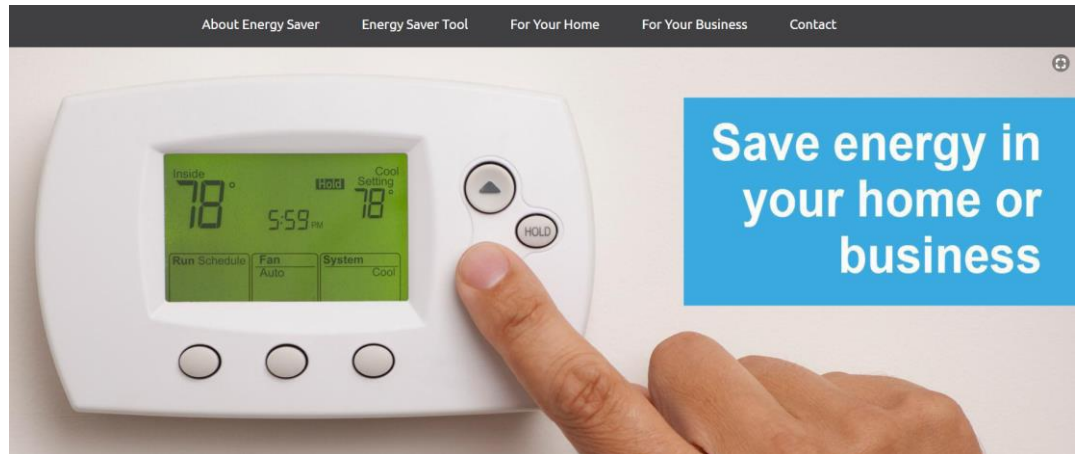

Domestic Energy Efficient Loan Program	Available for residential customers to become more energy efficient and invest in high-efficiency lighting and fixtures, high efficiency motors, and other equipment. Domestic Energy Solar for Small Business Program	Net Energy Metering (NEM) for every kWh generated, your business will offset its energy usage and receive an energy credit. For example, a business that uses 100,000 kWh of electricity annually will offset 100,000 kWh of electricity usage at retail and their respective net meter. Financial incentives are available for any amount generated. Offer only for customers whose usage is less than 100,000 kWh for electric energy and less than 100,000 kWh for natural gas. Domestic Energy Storage Rebate Program	For wholesale customers. Provides about 20 megawatts of peaking capacity that can be called upon when reserves capacity is short in the system. Domestic Energy Industrial Assessment Center	The Industrial Assessment Center provides energy assessments to manufacturers who are small and medium-sized enterprises within a 150 mile radius of Columbia, South Carolina. *Star - Tax Credits for Solar	The credits of up to \$2,000 for builders of new energy efficient single family and manufactured homes. The tax credit is available for homes built manufactured in the United States between January 1, 2018, and December 31, 2020.

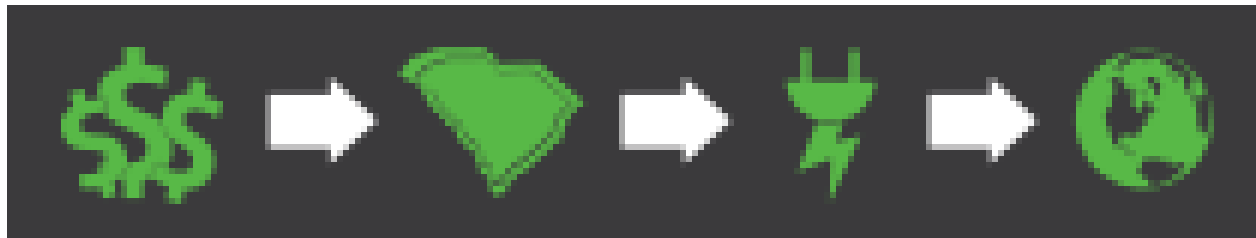

Energy Office Financing - Loans

- ConserFund Loan
 - Loans from \$25,000 up to \$500,000
 - 1.5% interest rate with terms of up to 10 years
 - Open to 501(c)(3) non-profits and government entities
 - Payments due quarterly for non-profits and annually for government entities

Energy Office Financing - Loans

- Energy Efficiency Revolving Loan (EERL)
 - Loans from \$50,000 up to \$1,000,000
 - Variable interest rate with terms of up to 10 years
 - Open to all commercial entities
 - Administered by the South Carolina Business Development Corporation

Energy Office Financing - Grants

- Mini-Grant Program
 - Competitive grant program with limited funding
 - Grants of up to \$10,000
 - High-impact demonstration projects
 - Open to 501(c)(3) non-profits and government entities
 - Opens at start of each fiscal year (July)
 - Brief application window
 - Applications selected for an award must be completed and reimbursed by end of fiscal year

- Energy Technical Assistance Program (ETAP)
- Free program available to SC state entities and non-profits
- Practical guidance for organizations to reduce energy use and costs
- Includes utility bill analysis, walk-through energy assessment and funding advisement*
